

Super Cup contest in Motocross Regulations

Organizers of the Super Cup strive to regulate the event in the fairest possible way. The Regulations are meant as a guide for the activity passes by permanent terms and the actual purpose of the regulations is above that, how these regulations could be interpreted by any competitor. All the participating parties are expected to act professionally and to respect the rights of others. Observance of the regulations doesn't guarantee safety. Every competitor accepts responsibility to evaluate safety aspects of vehicles and conditions, as well as takes risk of competitions.

1. Classes, motorcycles, participants

MX 7+	Motorcycles 65-85cc two-stroke and 75-150cc four-stroke	Age 7-14

MX 30+	Motorcycles with 125-500cc two-stroke and 250-650cc four-stroke engines	From 30
MX PRO	Motorcycles with 125-500cc two-stroke and 250-650cc four-stroke engines	From 14 Prolist
Kvadri 14+	Four wheel motorcycles. Athlete must have engine suppressor fixed on the right hand	From 14
Kvadri Pro	Four wheel motorcycles. Athlete must have engine suppressor fixed on the right hand	From 15 Prolist

- Start and end age of the athletes is reckoned by the year of birth
- **Athletes may take part in the events organized by other organizers**
- Any physical and legal persons could announce their own special prize
- With the permission of the team athletes may represent other clubs in the events of other organizers
- Athletes receive start numbers in the order of row. First rights of the number has its previous owner reserving it in Internet in terms specially stated by the organizer
- For additional fee 10 LVL it is possible to obtain personal start number for one season
- In all motorcycle classes athletes must have back numbers, as well as front and side start numbers of motorcycles
- Actual total classing leaders must have golden front number background. In the first stage – total classing leaders of the previous year
- Athletes have a possibility to obtain Super Cup Pilot cards
- Pilot card gives a possibility:
 - to get personal start number for entire season
 - to register for the event in Internet
 - to take part in the drawing of athlete prizes
 - to participate in team evaluation
 - to get lower participation fee cost
- The cards could be ordered in Internet page moto-x.lv
- All athletes must have accident insurance with a remark “Motosports”
- Foreign athletes without Super Cup cards are allowed to participate only in Pro classes

- The organizer has the rights not to confirm an athlete in Pro class, if his skill level is not corresponding

2. Course of the event

- Competition of every stage has qualification and 3 runs
- For the start in solo classes 40 athletes are qualified
- For the start in quadra classes 30 athletes are qualified
- Lengths of the run is 3+2 laps
- If an athlete for some reasons hasn't taken part in qualification trainings, then with the permission of the administering official of the event he may be allowed to the run, if there are free places
- The start is given by the starting gate
- Before every run in all motorcycle classes athletes are given an opportunity to drive examination lap with the time limit 4 min from the moment, when the first athlete drives into examination lap
- Runs of the classes could be joined
- A drawing could be organized for the athletes. Athletes without Super Cup Pilot cards don't take part in the drawing

3. Final

- Final is the last stage of the Super Cup competition
- In MX 13+ and MX30+ classes after the first run 20 best in every class go to Super Final, the others take part in B final. MX 13+ and MX30+ classes race together, but they are evaluated separately
- In Kvadri 14+ and Kvadri Pro classes after the first run 10 best in every class go to Super Final, the others take part in B final. Kvadri 14+ and Kvadri Pro classes race together, but they are evaluated separately
- In B final solo classes the first ten places win the score in decrescent succession (1st place – 10, 2nd place – 9 etc.)
- In B final quadra classes the first twenty places win the score in decrescent succession (1st place – 20, 2nd place – 19 etc.)

4. Evaluation

- After every stage winners of the first 5 places are awarded with the cups or medals
- Pro class athletes are paid money prizes for every run
1st place – 30 LVL, 2nd place – 20 LVL, 3rd place – 15 LVL, 4th place – 10 LVL, 5th place – 5 LVL
- Evaluation of the stage is determined by the sum of three runs
- In the case of identical score sums, the best places are taken into consideration, then – the place won in the last run
- In every run athletes get the score in accordance with the place they take as it is shown in the table:

- In total classing winners of first 5 places in every class are awarded
- Total classing results are determined by the score sum obtained in all runs
- In the case of identical score sums, the highest places are taken into consideration, then – the place won in the last run
- The athletes must attend the awarding ceremony wearing sports shirts without deceiving information

5. Teams

- **Any physical or legal person can announce a team**
- Athletes without Pilot cards don't give evaluation to the team
- During the season the athlete mustn't change a team
- Athlete gives a credit in one stage only in one class
- A team mustn't announce more than 5 athletes in one class
- A team receives a record of 4 best athlete score sums
- In stage classing winners of first 5 places are awarded with money prizes according to formula
- The highest place is taken by the team with 4 credits, then in decrescent succession
- In stage classing in the case of identical score sums the highest places are taken into consideration, then the highest place in the last run
- In team total classing winners of first 5 places are awarded
- In total classing in the case of identical score sums highest places of the team are taken into consideration, then – the place won in the last stage

6. Evaluation of manufacturer

- In the stage classing 3 best results of one motorcycle brand are included
- In evaluation score sum of 3 best results is included
- In the case of identical score sums, the highest places are taken into consideration, then – the highest place in the last run
- The highest place is taken by motorcycle brand with 3 credits, then in decrescent succession
- In total classing the dealer of the manufacturer, whose motorcycle brand has get the biggest score, is awarded
- In total classing in the case of identical score sums the highest places in stages are taken into consideration, then – the highest place in the last stage

7. Special prizes

- **Vilders lap** – an athlete, who has shown absolutely the fastest lap time in the stage, receives gift card from the firm Vilders in the value of 50 LVL

8. Honorary titles

- Honorary titles are won only in Pro classes
- The athletes, who during the season have gained not less than 80% of the possible score and at least in 50% of stages have taken one of first three places, won the title of Super Cup Sport Master Candidate (SMC)
- The athletes, who have been SMC two seasons running and in the third season fulfil the normative, gain the title of Sports Master (SM) and further are dismissed from participation fees in Super Cup events
- Every season the score is counted anew
- The athletes already having the title of Sports Master couldn't get it once more

- At the end of the season the organizer could assign the title of the Dynasty of the Year
- The jury of mass media assigns the title of the Most Progressive Athlete of the Year

9. Objections

- Objections to the results must be handed in written form not later than 20 min after official announcement of the results
- The objection must be supplemented by the security sum 50 LVL. If the objection is contented, objector receives the money back; otherwise the organizers of the Cup keep the money

10. Financial regulations

- Licences of the Super Cup are issued on one year
- Team licence fee is 50 LVL
- Athlete licence fee is 30 LVL
- Personal start number – 10 LVL
- Participation fee with Super Cup licences – 20 LVL
- Participation fee without Super Cup licences – 25 LVL
- Participation fee in Internet – 16 LVL (except Pro classes)
- Participation fee in Internet for Pro classes – 12 LVL
- Prize fund in Pro classes for a run
1st place – 30 LVL, 2nd place – 20 LVL, 3rd place – 15 LVL, 4th place – 10 LVL, 5th place – 5 LVL
- Sport Masters of the Super Cup are dismissed of any fees in Super Cup events
- Total classing leaders of the races are dismissed of participation fee in the following stage, if they have golden background of the front number.
